INTERNSHIP IN THE PROCESS ASSURANCE AND MANAGEMENT SUPPORT DIVISION

This project seeks to target areas for potential improvement between technical engineering and quality engineering disciplines at EUMETSAT.

In doing so, it will be necessary to understand the notion of quality standards and how they are implemented in practical terms at EUMETSAT.

The intern will be integrated in the MTG/EPS-SG Quality Assurance teams supervised by the GEO Quality Assurance Manager. The intern will attend the internal Quality Assurance meeting as an observer. Light induction to the organisation will also be provided.

DUTIES

Incoming quality inspections of physical goods;

QA witnessing test campaigns; Ensuring Integration, Verification & Validation (IV&V) of test campaigns are running according to procedure;

Assessing the quality of software codes;

Support preparation of practical QA training material; Following the project, the intern will elaborate a paper summarizing the outcome of his/her findings, including ideas which may be incorporated by organisation.
